

## देशभर में दीपावली मनाने को लेकर असमंजस की स्थिति

### ● विद्रान और ज्योतिषाचार्य ने निधारित की तिथि

#### 1 नवंबर को अमावस्या तिथि, शाम के समय ही होगी समाप्त

देशभर में प्रकाश पर्व दीपावली की तैयारियां पूरे उत्साह और उमंग के साथ जारी हैं। इसके साथ ही चुनाव आयोग ने बोते एक साल के पांच ऐसे विशेष मामलों का हवाला भी दिया है। आयोग ने इन मामलों का जिक्र करते हुए कहा कि देश की सभवत के चुनावी कार्यों पर आदान हमलों से बचाना चाहिये। चुनाव आयोग ने कागेस पार्टी को लिखे गए प्रवर्त में 'सामाज्ञ' संदेह का दावा कर हवा बनाने का आपेक्षण लगाया। इस संदर्भ में आयोग ने कागेस को सख्ती के साथ भविष्य में निराशा आरोपों से बचने का परामर्श भी दिया है। इतना ही नहीं चुनाव आयोग ने कागेस और अन्य राजनीतिक दलों को मतदान और मतगणना के दिनों जैसे संसदनीयतालीक समय पर निराशा और सनसनीखेज शिकायतों के प्रति आगाह किया। उन्हें चेताया है कि यह प्रयास कपी भी सच को छूट और छूट को सच नहीं कर सकता। चुनाव आयोग ने असंविधानक चुनावी नीतियों का सामान करने के बजाए अनावश्यक और अर्थमाल प्रलाप के लिए पार्टी को आड़े हाथों लिया है। आयोग ने कागेस से ढूँढ़ और ठोस कदम उठाने और तुक्के शिकायतों की प्रवृत्ति पर अवृशु लगाने का आग्रह किया।

#### उत्तराखण्ड में 1 नवंबर को मनाई जाएगी

उत्तराखण्ड के कुमाऊं और गढ़वाल के ज्योतिषाचार्य व पंडितोंने कहा है कि प्रदेशभर में दिवाली 1 नवंबर को मनाई जाएगी। उन्होंने पर्व को लेकर आम बैठक की, जिसमें सर्वसम्मति से एक नवंबर को दिवाली मनाने का फैसला लिया गया है। ऐसा नियम है कि अमावस्या के 12 बजे के बाद लगने पर पर्व अपले दिन मनाया जाता है।

चूंकि 31 अक्टूबर को अमावस्या 2 बजकर 56 मिनट पर शुरू होगी, जो 1 तारीख को शाम साल 6 बजे तक रहेगी। अमावस्या का प्रदोष काल शाम को होगा। प्रदोष काल की अमावस्या साढ़े 6 बजे तक रहेगी। ऐसे में उन्होंने फैसला किया कि दिवाली का पर्व एक नवंबर को ही मनाना चाहिए। वहीं, सरकारी कर्मचारियों को अवकाश 31 अक्टूबर को है।

#### बिहार में गुरुवार को ही होगी दिवाली, कार्तिक मास की अमावस्या तिथि

बिहार में भी दिवाली 31 अक्टूबर को मनाई जाएगी। पंडित मनोज शास्त्री के अनुसार, दिक्षिणी कार्तिक मास की अमावस्या तिथि बो मनाई जाती है। इस साल 31 अक्टूबर को दिन में 3 बजकर 12 मिनट से अमावस्या लग रही है, जो 1 नवंबर को शाम 5 बजकर 53 मिनट तक रहेगी। त्रृत या त्वेतर में उदया तिथि देखी जाती है, लेकिन दिवाली के बाद प्रदोष काल पर विचार किया जाता है। दिवाली के दिन सूर्योत्तर के बाद दीपक जलाने का विधान है। 1 नवंबर को अमावस्या तिथि शाम के समय ही समाप्त हो जाएगी, जिसके कारण प्रदोष काल प्राप्त नहीं होगा। इस वजह से 31 अक्टूबर को दिवाली का पर्व मनाना बेहतर रहेगा।

#### गुंबद में दिवाली की तिथि को लेकर ज्योतिषियों की राय अलग-अलग

एक तरफ मुईद्दिकर दिवाली की तैयारियों में व्यस्त है, वहीं दूसरी ओर इस महापर्व की तिथि को लेकर असमंजस है। इस बार दिवाली की तिथि को लेकर ज्योतिषियों की राय अलग-अलग है। कुछ लोगों का मनाना है कि छुट्टी 31 अक्टूबर को है, जबकि बड़े मंदिरों में दिवाली 1 नवंबर को मनाई जानी चाहिए। जबकि कुछ का मनाना है कि पर्व 31 अक्टूबर को ही मनाया जाना चाहिए। ज्योतिषियों के एकमत नहीं होने से कई घरों में दोनों दिन लक्ष्मी पूजन करने वाले तैयारियों में एक बार्ता आयी है। दिवाली की तिथि पर असमंजस दूर करने के लिए शास्त्रों में खट्ट बातेया गया है। इस साल कार्तिक अमावस्या 31 अक्टूबर की दोपहर 3-5-4 बजे शुरू होकर 3 अगले दिन 1 नवंबर की शाम 6-17 बजे समाप्त होगा। ऐसे में, अमावस्या तिथि दो दिन प्रदोष काल में है। धर्म शास्त्रों में साफ कहा गया है कि यदि दो दिन अमावस्या प्रदोष व्यापिनी हों, तो दूसरे दिन वाली अमावस्या में ही दिवाली मनाया जाना शास्त्र के मुताबिक सही है। 31 अक्टूबर को दिवाली मानाने के पीछे का तरफ पिरु कार्य भी है। पिरु देव पूजन का मतलब प्रातः काल में अस्थग स्नान, देव पूजन और दोपहर में पारंपर्ग कर्म आदि है। यदि दिवाली एक दिन पहले मनाई जाए, तो यह सभी काम लक्ष्मी पूजन के बाद में होंगे, जो सही नहीं होगा। ज्योतिषाचार्य व बालकृष्ण मिश्र ने कहा कि वर्ष सिंधु पुरुषार्थ वितामणि, तिथि निर्णयन और द्रव विवेक पर्व आदि ग्रंथों के मुताबिक दो दिन प्रदोष काल के मामले अमावस्या की व्याप्ति कम या अधिक होने पर दूसरे दिन अमावस्या के दिन लक्ष्मी पूजन करना शास्त्र सम्मत है।
